The Joanie Abdu Mobile Mammography Unit

The first mobile unit in eastern Ohio to offer **3D mammography**, this advanced technology enables women to have a state-of-the-art screening mammogram in the convenience of their own community. 3D mammography exams are clinically proven to detect 41 percent more invasive breast cancers, while simultaneously reducing unnecessary callbacks (false positives) up to 40 percent. With 3D technology, doctors can examine breast tissue layer-by-layer, in multiple views, with fine details more visible. These extra exam views help physicians better distinguish invasive cancers, especially in women with dense breast tissue.

The Joanie Abdu Mobile Mammography Van also offers **bone density screenings**. In less than a minute, a patient's bone mineral density can be estimated based on an ultrasound measurement of the heel. This fast, radiation-free bone density screening is a state-of-the-art detection tool available for identifying patients at risk of developing osteoporosis and in assessing their risk of future fracture.

Who should have a mammogram?

Beginning at age 40, women should have a yearly mammogram. If you have certain risk factors your doctor may suggest you have a mammogram at an earlier age.

Mammograms are covered by most health plans. For the best coverage, please verify that Mercy Health and the Joanie Abdu Comprehensive Breast Care Center are in-network providers with your insurance carrier.
