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### ***Lake County Drug Repository***

On the inventory page you will find a list of medicines that the Lake County Prescription Assistance program may have in stock. The amount in stock varies monthly. You should always be prepared to find your prescribed medicine at another location if we do not have it in stock.

To be eligible you must be a resident of the State of Ohio and need assistance in paying for you medicine. Preference is given to those who reside in Lake, Geauga and Ashtabula Counties. The cost will vary between generic and non-generic but the cost per prescription will be twenty (20) dollars or less.

We may help in other services also including:

- If medicine is not available or if you don't qualify, information may be provided where you may obtain you prescription at a reasonable cost
